Not all codes mean an item can be recycled via curbside collection.

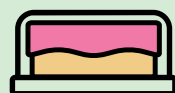


**PET**

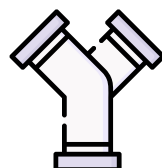
**CODES 1 & 2:**

These are the most commonly recycled items. Water or shampoo bottles are generally always accepted.

**LDPE**

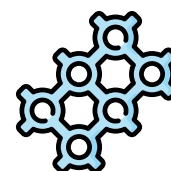
Low-Density Polyethylene

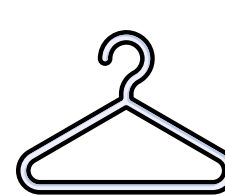

Items include hangers, straws, bags or thin plastics which cannot be recycled at our facility.

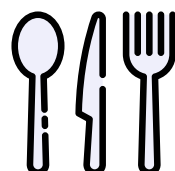

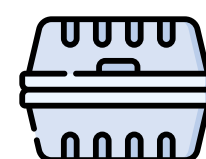
